The meeting was called to order by President Larry Coffman at 10:05am. President Coffman led the salute to the flag and read the Auxiliary Prayer.

Motion made by Vikki Egry/Carol McInnes/approved the minutes of 7-17-24 as presented.

Dr. Clint Purvance shared a status report of the hospital. This year is the first in the last 4 that the hospital is doing well financially. At present the hospital is reviewing with staff what they would like to see in the new hospital as far as equipment, design and space. They have added another pediatrician and General Surgeon to the staff. Wayne Prim and his foundation have donated \$10 million to the new hospital in Nevada. Mr. Prim passed away in March at the age of 97.

Chris Henderson shared that Barton will have a Health Faire at Bijou School on 10-17-24 from 3-6pm. The auxiliary will have a booth set up with giveaways. The Health Faire will be giving flu shots.
